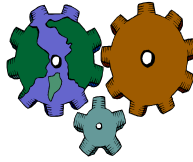
## GPCS Summer Camp

## Why Summer Camp?

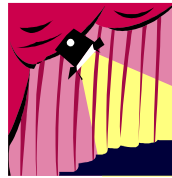
